

• 7:00 - 7:20 a.m.: Departure toward Tafí del Valle via Route 38.

- Quebrada de Los Sosa: Enjoy the lush subtropical vegetation and a stop at the "Monumento al Indio."
- El Mollar: Visit Parque Los Menhires, home to ancient pre-Hispanic stone monoliths.
- Tafí del Valle: Free time for lunch (not included). • Continue the ascent to El Infiernillo (3,042 meters above sea

level) and then descend through the scenic Cuesta de Ampimpa.

Enter the Calchaquí Valleys, surrounded by centuries-old

- cardones (giant cacti) and the Santa María River.
- Stop for an exterior view of the Ruins of Quilmes.
- Arrival in Cafayate and hotel accommodation.
